


## 50<sup>th</sup> Street | US 41 Railroad Crossing Replacement Project

Tampa, FL – Beginning early Monday morning, June 20, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will close 50<sup>th</sup> Street (US 41) just south of 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue/Broadway Avenue for railroad crossing replacement work in Tampa. This closure is necessary for CSX to replace the railroad tracks closest to 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue/ Broadway Avenue. 50<sup>th</sup> Street is expected to be closed for approximately 10 days, weather permitting.

During this closure motorists will not be able to cross the tracks. Through traffic will be detoured around the work zone using Adamo Drive (SR 60), 39<sup>th</sup> Street and 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue. 50<sup>th</sup> Street will remain open to provide local access to both sides of the railroad crossing.

Electronic message boards and detour signs will be used to assist motorists traveling through the detour. Motorists should anticipate heavier than normal volumes of traffic on all of these roads during this closure.
